Dear Secretary Buffaloe:

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is approving the State of North Carolina's Substantial Action Plan Amendment (APA) 2 for Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds for long-term recovery needs from Tropical Storm Fred (2021). The Department allocated \$13,186,000 in CDBG-DR funds to the State for this purpose, administered under grant number P-21-NC-37-LDZ1.

After a reevaluation of the unmet needs assessment, the State is adding a Rapid Recovery Fund of \$4,000,000 to focus on immediate housing recovery needs due to the dual impacts of Tropical Storm Fred and Hurricane Helene on Haywood County. The following table summarizes modifications to the previous Action Plan.
