



Home Damaged in Hurricane Matthew?

Help is Available

If you need help repairing your home from damage caused by Hurricane Matthew, the state of North Carolina may be able to assist you by providing a housing recovery grant. Funds are available for homeowners and renters. **Go to rebuild.nc.gov/apply for more information.**

Step 1 Schedule an Appointment

To apply for a Hurricane Matthew housing recovery grant, you must schedule an appointment and meet with an application specialist. Your application specialist will help you walk through the full application. This visit may take up to two hours.

Apply as soon as possible. Application centers are open November 30 in Cumberland, Edgecombe, Robeson and Wayne counties. Schedule your appointment by calling:
